# The Pursuing Love of God

Ephesians 3:14-21

### **Introduction:**

### Today we begin a series of messages on the subject of God's Love.

### Ephesians 3:14-21

14 For this reason I bow my knees before the Father,

15 from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name,

16 that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner man,

# Ephesians 3:14-21

17 so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; and that you, being rooted and grounded in love,

18 may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth,

# Ephesians 3:14-21

19 and to know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled up to all the fullness of God.

# Ephesians 3:14-21

20 Now to Him who is able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us,

21 to Him be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever. Amen.

In Ephesians 1 Paul describes the eternal relationship we enjoy with God once we have trusted in Jesus alone and experience as a result of this trust having our lives eternally joined to Jesus life. **Paul describes it with the phrase** "in Christ". Chapter 1 gives us many of the benefits of this relationship.

In Ephesians 2 Paul describes who we were before we trusted in Jesus and who we are now "in Christ". **Specifically, He describes how we have** been brought near to God, how we all have come together from many different backgrounds to make one body of Christ, one family of God.

Together we are joint heirs with Jesus of His eternal kingdom. We are His Body, the church, and Jesus is our head -our leader-our life.

In Ephesians 3 Paul continues to speak about how God called him to serve as a faithful steward in the church. He communicates that all of us together are called to serve as faithful stewards. In the passage we have read Paul now in light of all of these truths begins to pray.

He prays to God that all of us would be strengthened by the power of the Holy Spirit in our inner man so that Christ Jesus can dwell in our hearts by faith. To dwell means to be at home.

His prayer is not only would Jesus enter our lives but that he will be able to be at home there. Paul then prays that each of us would be rooted and grounded in God's Love.

This means we would allow God's love for us to be our source of life and our foundation for how we understand God, how we understand ourselves, how we understand others and how we understand the world around us.

He is praying that our worldview, our view of self and our understanding of God would come from God's love. The roots determine everything about the formation of the tree as well as its fruit. God wants us at the very core of who we are, in our inner man to be rooted and grounded in His love.

These two images of roots and foundations speak to the starting place of our lives. As born again children of God all we are, all we do, all we believe is to be rooted and grounded in the knowledge of God's love.

Paul continues to pray that from this being rooted and grounded in God's love we would grow to comprehend all of the dimensions of God's love. This growth in the understanding and implementation of God's love from every angle is done together with all the saints (vs. 18) (believers).

We cannot fully understand the fullness of God's love by ourselves. We must experience it and grow to understand and apply it in the context of being and serving together.

This love of Christ surpasses ordinary knowledge which is why the world is so confused in its understanding of genuine love. The love of God must be revealed to us by God as we live out in daily life this relationship with Jesus together.

Verse 20 tells us that Jesus is able to work within us to accomplish things way beyond what we can dream up or ever think to ask. Jesus alone receives glory for how God's love grows in us and through us.

Our prayer is that Jesus would be glorified as He reveals to us the depths of His love for us and His love for the world.

**Over the next few weeks as God leads** we hope to consider together the pursing love of God, the compelling love of God, the transforming love of God, and the eternal love of God. **Today we will focus our attention to** how God's love pursues us.

In Romans 3:10-11 Paul quotes from several passages of the Old Testament Scriptures to show us that no one is righteous. We also see that no one understands God and there is no one seeking God.

### **Romans 3:10-11**

10 as it is written, "There is none righteous, not even one;

11 There is none who understands, There is none who seeks for God;

### Therefore, apart from God's love pursuing us we would never have a hope of being righteous in God's eyes. We would never be acceptable to a Holy God.

Yet because of God's pursuing love we can know God personally. We can be forgiven of our sin and cleansed. We can be covered by the blood of Jesus and therefore considered eternally righteous in Christ.

### God pursued us by His love and grace and through Christ he can take away our unrighteousness and give us the gift of righteousness.

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### **Romans 3:20-24**

20 because by the works of the Law no flesh will be justified in His sight; for through the Law comes the knowledge of sin.

### **Romans 3:20-24**

21 But now apart from the Law the righteousness of God has been manifested, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets,

### **Romans 3:20-24**

22 even the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all those who believe; for there is no distinction;

### **Romans 3:20-24**

### 23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

### **Romans 3:20-24**

### 24 being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus;

### 2 Corinthians 5:21

21 He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

No one understands God on his or her own. God's pursuing love began to reveal **Himself to mankind through** relationships with a few people, through the giving of His Word, and through His love for His chosen people through whom He had promised to bless all of the nations.

## Now because God's love pursued us in Jesus we can grow to understand God's will, God's ways, God's purposes, etc.-God Himself.

We can also begin to understand ourselves in the light of the truth that God is our creator. In Ephesians 3:14 we read that Paul's prayer was to the "Father from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name."

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## Hebrews 1:1-3

1 God, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in many portions and in many ways,

## Hebrews 1:1-3

<sup>2</sup> in these last days has spoken to us in His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the world.

## Hebrews 1:1-3

**3 And He is the radiance of His glory** and the exact representation of His nature, and upholds all things by the word of His power. When He had made purification of sins, He sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high,

## John 14:6-9

6 Jesus \*said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

## John 14:6-9

7 If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; from now on you know Him, and have seen Him."

## John 14:6-9

8 Philip \*said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is enough for us."

## John 14:6-9

9 Jesus \*said to him, "Have I been so long with you, and yet you have not come to know Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?

No one seeks God on his or her own. God's love pursues us. God places within each person the knowledge of Himself in a form which creates a spiritual thirst.

## This is why mankind hungers to know God. We do not have to search for God. God love has pursued us, found us, and revealed Himself to us in Jesus.

In Romans 5:3-8 Paul shares that we are able to rejoice in our tribulations because we know that God's love is working in us and around us even in the midst of tribulations.

## **Romans 5:3-8**

<sup>3</sup> And not only this, but we also exult in our tribulations, knowing that tribulation brings about perseverance;

## **Romans 5:3-8**

4 and perseverance, proven character; and proven character, hope;

## **Romans 5:3-8**

5 and hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us.

## **Romans 5:3-8**

6 For while we were still helpless, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly.

## **Romans 5:3-8**

<sup>7</sup> For one will hardly die for a righteous man; though perhaps for the good man someone would dare even to die.

## **Romans 5:3-8**

8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

We are led by God's love through these difficult times to the experience of hope. Hope is the final step of the maturing process God's love leads us through in each experience of life.

## Throughout our journey in this world we experience God's love being poured out within our hearts by His indwelling Holy Spirit.

How do we know God loves us? When we were helpless, hopeless, and lost in our sin Jesus died for us. **God demonstrated** (Put on display) (targeted) His love towards us in that while we were sinners Jesus still chose to die for us. This is a pursuing love!

## Luke 15:1-2

## <sup>1</sup> Now all the tax collectors and the sinners were coming near Him to listen to Him.

## Luke 15:1-2

2 Both the Pharisees and the scribes began to grumble, saying, "This man receives sinners and eats with them."

As we see in Luke 15: 1-2, Luke tells us that Jesus chose to allow the tax gatherers (traitors) and the sinners (non-religious /non practicing Jews), to sit with Him and eat a meal with Him. We would call this group unchurched or de-churched people today.

This group, of non-religious people, was comfortable around Jesus and they were listening to Him. His welcoming presence in their midst was evidence of God's pursuing love.

The religious leaders began to grumble and finally spoke up to say; **"This man receives sinners** and eats with them!" What a wonderful behavior of which to be accused! **Thank God Jesus receives sinners!** Jesus responded by telling 3 stories which described God's pursuing love.

## 1. Shepherd and the lost sheep

## Woman and the lost coin

2.

## 3. Loving father and the two lost boys

## Those who seek to be accepted by God by doing religious works will seldom understand the grace of God's pursuing love.

Jesus knew the crowd to whom He spoke was filled with those who knew they were sinners in a pig pen of life. He also knew others saw themselves as close to God by comparing themselves to others and keeping a list of rules.

### Both groups were equally far from God.

# Both groups were being pursued by God's love.

## Both would have to respond to God's grace by trusting in Jesus alone.

### God's love pursues us seeking to bring us to trust in Jesus for salvation.

Our sin separates us from God and God's love reveals to us this truth.

God's love reveals to us the truth that Jesus paid for us the penalty of death and separation when He died on the cross for us.

Jesus paid the price so we who trusted in Him could be forgiven, cleansed, and made by God to be a new person in Christ.

Through Jesus death and resurrection we can be given an eternal relationship with God.

If today you do not have a personal relationship with God through Jesus please know that God loves you & God is pursuing you in love to offer you the gift of eternal life.

### Let God catch you!

Acknowledge the truth that you are a sinner. Seek God's forgiveness and cleansing of sin that is only possible through trusting Jesus.

### Ask Jesus to rescue you from the penalty of death and separation from God which we all deserve because of our sin.

Jesus loves you. Jesus died for you. Jesus rose from the dead conquering sin and death to offer you eternal life.

**Trust Him today!** 

God doesn't stop pursuing us with His love when we become His children.

Like a godly parent continues to love and guide a child from birth to maturity,

God's love pursues us to guide us, to mold us, to help us grow, to know all of the dimensions of His great love for us.

#### His love continues to pursue us until the day we see Jesus face to face and become like Jesus.

Even then His love will pursue us as we fully enjoy His presence for all eternity.

His Holy Spirit within us convicts and guides us.

His Spirit empowers and cleanses us as needed.

His Word teaches, reproofs, corrects, and instructs us.

> All of these are evidence of God's pursuing love.
